

Lingenio Translation Server OmegaT Plugin Installation Instructions

1 Installation

To install the LTS Plugin for OmegaT, open the `plugins/` directory of your OmegaT installation and copy the `.jar` file there. The next time you start OmegaT, the plugin is available from the Menu under Options > Machine Translate > Lingenio Translation Server.

2 Setup

You need a valid API key for the Plugin to actually translate text. If you don't already have a key, you can obtain one from `shop.lingenio.de`.

2.1 Windows users

- Locate the configuration file `OmegaT.l4J.ini` (the default location is `C:\Program Files (x86)\OmegaT`).
- To edit this file, you need Administrator mode, or to move it temporarily to a different location on your hard drive.
- Open `OmegaT.l4J.ini` in a plain text editor
- Add the following line to the text in the file: `-Dlingenio.api.key=XXXXX` (where "XXXXX" is the API key provided by Lingenio).
- Save `OmegaT.l4J.ini` (and if necessary, move it back to the OmegaT folder).

2.2 Mac users

- Right-click on OmegaT.app and select "Show Package Contents".
- Right-click on the file Info.plist and select your preferred editor to open the file.
- Find the lines:
`<key>apple.awt.graphics.UseQuartz</key>`
`<string>true</string>`
and immediately after them, add the lines:
`<key>lingenio.api.key</key>`
`<string>XXXXX</string>`
where "XXXXX" is your LTS API key.
- Save Info.plist.

2.3 Linux users

Make sure that you have the Kaptain launcher installed, then enter the LTS API key in the relevant field on the Connectivity tab.

2.4 Users launching OmegaT from the command line or by a script

- Add the following argument to the launch command:
`-Dlingenio.api.key=XXXXX`
where "XXXXX" is your LTS API key.

The basic launch command with the LTS API key added will therefore be:

```
java -jar -Dlingenio.api.key=XXXXXX OmegaT.jar
```
