1 Installation

1.1 SDL Trados Studio 2014

To use the Lingenio Translation Server™Plugin in SDL Trados Studio 2014, you need to manually copy the plugin files to a specific directory. SDL Trados Studio 2014 will then find these files and use them the next time you restart it.

1.1.1 Windows XP

Windows XP users need to place the plugin file in `C:\Documents and Settings\[UserName]\Application Data\SDL\SDL Trados Studio\11\Plugins\Packages\`

1.1.2 Windows Vista / 7 / 8

Users of Windows Vista, Windows 7 and Windows 8 need to place the plugin file in `C:\Users\[UserName]\AppData\Roaming\SDL\SDL Trados Studio\11\Plugins\Packages\`

2 Usage

You need a valid API key for the Plugin to actually translate text. If you don't already have a key, you can obtain one from shop.lingenio.de.

When you create a new project, in the panel titled 'Translation memories and automated translation', you can add the Lingenio Translation Server Plugin as a translation provider

for this project. After you select the LTS Plugin, a window will appear where you need to enter your API key.

You can return to said window any time by opening your project settings, selecting the LTS plugin and clicking 'Settings'.
